

TWEED RANGE SCENIC DRIVE

This drives takes you into the Border Ranges National Park with spectacular views, waterfalls, sparkling creeks and rugged ridges across both New South Wales and Queensland.

The Border Ranges National Park has two entrances; one at the western section (via Wiangaree) and the other at the southern section (via Wadeville), an entry fee does apply. The National Park offers the chance to dust off your binoculars and go bird watching or search for the Red Cedar trees, believed to be 1,000 years old. From Murwillumbah, Nimbin or Lismore, explore the region and stay overnight at the Wadeville Woollies.

Follow the escarpment through the Border

Ranges National Park, exiting at the Sheepstation Creek rest area.

At Kyogle, pick up a Border Ranges brochure from the Kyogle Visitor Information Centre. From there, head north to Wiangaree and turn right into Lynches Creek Road which then becomes Simes Road. Turn right onto Tweed Range Scenic Drive which traverses the Border Ranges National Park (44km of all-weather gravel road). Follow the road through the park, take a stroll through the rainforest and enjoy a picnic. Concluding the journey, depart through the southern entrance which will bring you onto Murwillumbah-Kyogle Road.

THINGS TO DO ALONG THE WAY

- Do the walk to the Pinnacle Lookout and stand on the edge of an ancient volcano
- Grab some fresh local produce from a roadside fruit stall and have a break or picnic at either Black Butts, Forest Tops, Bar Mountain or Sheepstation Creek picnic areas
- Wander through a stand of ancient Antarctic Beech trees at Bar Mountain

Brindle Creek Walk – 5km one way, 3 hrs, medium

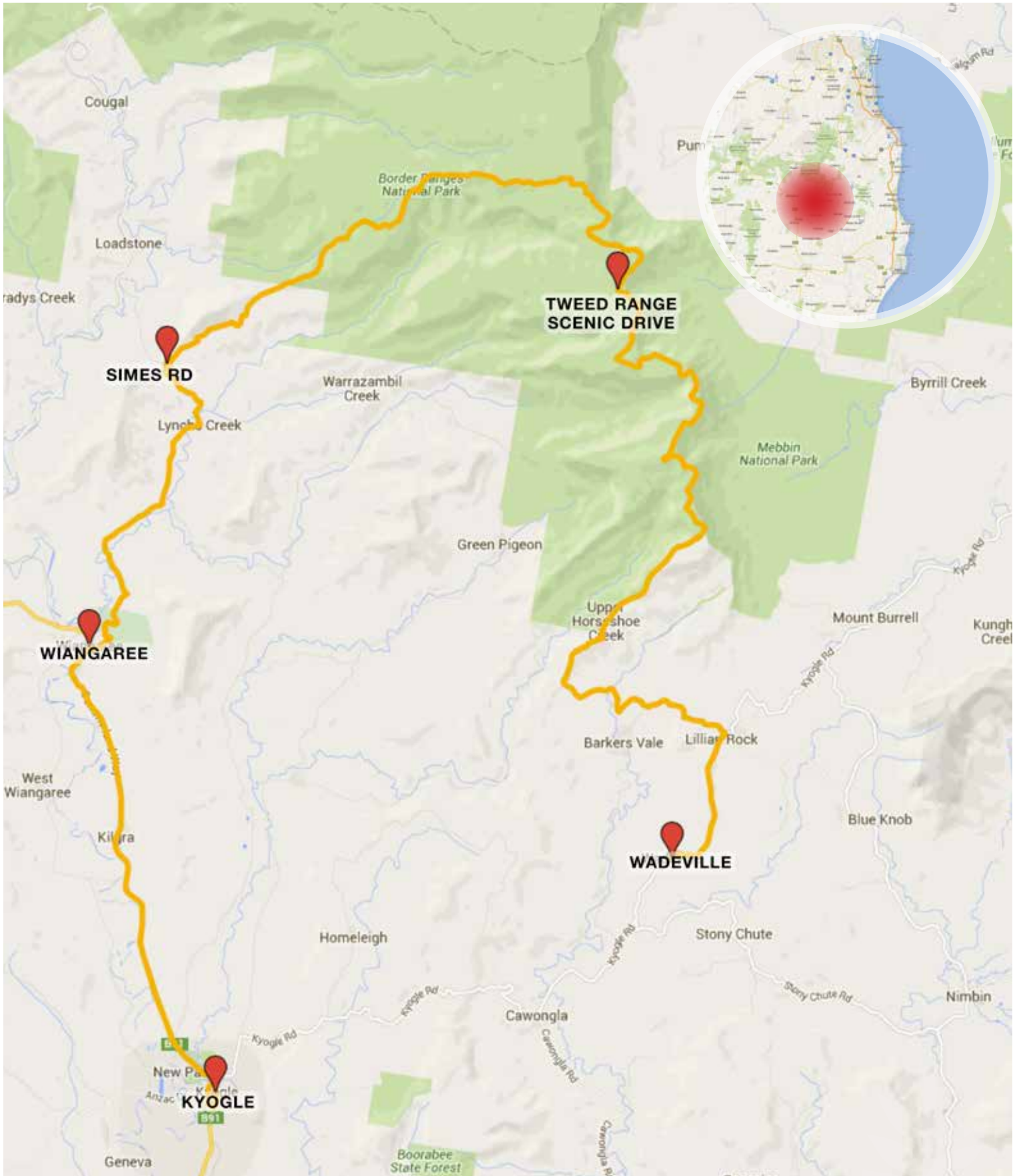
